Our Story

Established in 1992 by husband and wife, Gordon and Susan Tait, Tait began in a small factory in Melbourne, Australia. Gordon, a sheet metal craftsman, and Susan, a creative textile designer, noticed an absence of well-designed and made outdoor products. 30 years later, Tait's pieces have become icons of contemporary Australian design, renowned for their durability and longevity.

Proudly manufacturing 95% of their products in Australia, Tait credits the high performance and long lifespan of their pieces to their passionate and skilled craftspeople. With each piece made to order locally; there are many options for customisation of colour, material and finish, with the added benefit of short lead times. Tait's local, made-to-order model means fewer resources are wasted, and most products can be refurbished throughout their lifetime.

Authentic Australian Design

Nurturing and investing in authentic Australian design is part of Tait's DNA. Collaborating with Australian designers, Tait produce collections which enhance our connection with the outdoors. Each Tait product is designed to embody luxury, longevity and low-maintenance; and are engineered with materials which are both beautiful and high-performing.

Symbolising their proud heritage as makers, a Tait 'makers mark' appears on each piece. This mark honours Tait's passionate designers and craftspeople, while revealing the authenticity of the piece. Furthering their commitment to authentic design, Tait are proud members of the AUTHENTIC DESIGN ALLIANCE®, a social enterprise who fight design theft and promote the value of investing in authentic design.













Sustainability


Tait is committed to continually improving sustainability outcomes throughout their operations, whilst producing beautiful, high-performing, and authentic design made to last.

Tait's sustainability program extends to the following key areas: Environmental & Waste Minimisation; Local Manufacturing; Materials, Finishes & Processes; Energy Efficiency; Product Lifecycle, Stewardship & Quality.

Tait's key sustainability measures include

- Each year Tait offsets approximately 60 tonnes of CO2 from entering the atmosphere via solar.
- 95% of Tait's products are made in Australia.
- Tait products enjoy a long lifespan, and Tait offers a refurbishment service to extend their life.
- Tait's products are predominantly made from environmentally-friendly materials.
- Tait's recycling program includes the recycling of all soft plastics as well as metals, timbers and foam offcuts.
- Tait's cardboard packaging is sourced from sustainably grown, reforested plantations, and their soft plastic bag packaging is 100% recycled.
