

Exterior Oil Reapplication

THIS PRODUCT IS FOR USE WITH TAIT'S
SPOTTED GUM TIMBERS ONLY

A life spent outdoors for your timber furniture means it will likely be subjected to extreme's in humidity and temperature (to which timber naturally adapts). If you wish to retain your furniture's ex-factory finish we recommend following these instructions.

Please note:

- DO NOT use a high pressure cleaner as this damages the timber fibres.
- DO NOT use steel wool, wire brushes or any abrasive implements for every day cleaning.
- Tait recommend reapplication of the oil in mild weather conditions as extreme heat and cold affects oil application.

1. Remove surface dirt and discolouration on timber surface with a hand held scourer, or scrub with warm soapy water and a soft bristled brush. Ensure the timber is dry before proceeding to the next step.

2. Before applying the oil, lightly sand the timber ensuring all dust is removed.

3. Open the tin and stir thoroughly. Soak the supplied cloth (or a clean cloth) in the oil and apply to the timber following the grain. One liberal coat should be sufficient if regular maintenance is carried out. If the timber still appears dry the apply a second coat.

4. Please allow 24 hours for the finish to harden thoroughly.
