Powder Coat Touch-up Application Guide

Touch-up kit includes:

- 50ml powder coat touch-up paint
- Fine tipped paintbrush
- · Isopropyl wipe

Notes:

- Paint drips may occur so protect any areas you do not want to damage.
- Using a piece of scrap paper/card practice and test. Remove excess paint from brush before application.

Application process:

- 1. Clean the affected area with the supplied isopropyl wipe to ensure grease and debris is thoroughly removed.
- 2. Shake paint bottle.
- 3. Using the supplied paint brush apply a small amount of paint to affected area/s. Best results are achieved with several light coats, rather than a single thick coat
- 4. Allow the paint to dry and reapply if required.

If you make a mistake (e.g. touch wet paint before drying):

- 1. Let the area dry to 'touch dry'.
- 2. Use the isopropyl wipe to remove paint.
- 3. Start again following the above steps.
