Inspired by the unique forms found in Australian native flora, the Correa Table encourages easy conversation through thoughtful design and ergonomic features. Requiring special metal spinning tooling to craft, the base's gently bulbous form echoes the soft bell-shaped curves of the Correa flower, also known as the Native Fuchsia. Available in three diameters, as well as a pill shape, Correa's elegant top comes in powder coated aluminium to create a seamless whole with its metal base.

The Correa Collection is our newest dining collection, inviting people to gather around for great conversations and lasting memories. Drawing from environmental and industrial inspiration, from Australian natives to Bauhaus innovation, Correa echoes its floral namesake in more ways than one. The collection is both beautiful and tough, and crafted to last in challenging conditions across Australia.

Harnessing manufacturing technologies and skills honed over 30+ years, the Correa Collection is engineered in a range of premium materials and finishes including stainless steel and aluminium offered in 22 powder coat colours, and high-performance fabrics.

The collection comprises 8 table variations allowing for solid metal or porcelain tops, or with a cutout hole for ice bucket, planter, or umbrella. There are also 3 seating options – the Correa Chair, Correa Lounger and Correa Rocker – which can be either full metal or fixed with upholstered panels.

Like all Tait collections, Correa is embedded with circularity, using recyclable materials, and purpose-designed for refurbishment. Seat and back pads can be reupholstered, frames can be stripped and re-powder coated, and glides and rubber fittings can be replaced.

Suitable for retail, hospitality, workplace, education and residential settings, both indoor and outdoor.

All Tait pieces are made locally and come with a 10-year structural warranty.

How to care for your Correa Table | Porcelain



GENERAL CARE

At Tait, we make products for life. Our products are crafted from high-performance materials designed to withstand the elements across our diverse Australian climate zones. We make design decisions with both form and function in mind, combining timeless and cutting-edge designs with beautiful finishes in order to elevate your outdoor (or indoor) experience.

Our collections are handcrafted from weather-resistant materials, making each piece a durable choice. In order to maintain their look and feel over time, Tait items need ongoing care and maintenance. The frequency of maintenance will vary depending on the level of care you want to provide, your personal standards and requirements as well as the environment within which the product lives.

Please refer to the care instructions relevant to the specific materials and finishes of your product, and take note of the warranty details to understand the parameters.

We finish making our products by hand, and know they can live a long and useful life when equally cared for in your hands. For those rare occasions where it's needed, we offer a 10-year structural warranty (Australia only), made possible by the stringent quality control standards within our factory on Wurundjeri Land in Thomastown, Victoria.

The warranty does not cover:

- Damage from mishandling, mistreatment, abuse or lack of maintenance.
- Natural ageing, general wear and tear and fading.
- Damage from organic or man-made matter including mineral deposits, soils and fertilisers; or from the build-up of environmental mould.
- Corrosion spots at the weld joins (which do not affect the structural integrity of the product and are a natural outcome of the material used).
- Corrosion of steel furniture and parts as a result of hard seafront or chlorinated environments.
- Any variations in colour, shade or gloss levels of finishes including stone tops and timbers.
- Changes of heart based on personal preference.
- Transportation costs for replacement parts/products, or labour costs for repair (these are charged at our discretion)
Goods that have been held in storage for any period (due to the potential impact of environmental extremities in certain storage facilities).
- Tait offers a 1-year warranty on upholstery, this includes foam and finishing (stitching, zips etc).

The above Tait warranty terms are accepted by the customer and end-user upon order and supply.

POWDERCOAT

CARE & MAINTENANCE

Wash regularly with warm soapy water and mild detergent using a soft cloth. For commercial, industrial or marine environments we recommend monthly maintenance. Always rinse well with water, to remove any remaining detergent.

Avoid steam cleaning, pressure washing, abrasive cleansers, steel brushes/wools and cleaners containing chlorine. Avoid scratching the surface by dry dusting. Never use strong solvents to clean powder coated surfaces. Aggressive solvents such as turpentine, white spirits, thinners, citrus based cleaners, Spray and Wipe, and other aggressive solvents are harmful to the extended life of the powder coated surface. Do not allow detritus, organic or man-made matter to settle on the product surface. We recommend removing any buildup of mineral deposits leaching from soils and fertilisers, should it occur on Tait's planters.

Rough treatment of powder-coated furniture can result in chipping of the coated surface; this is not covered under warranty.

Most Tait products come with protective fittings – stacking glides, bumpers, socks/feet and glides. These aid in protection against chipping and scratching. Powder coated chairs are designed to be set in place gently.

Touch-up paint may be purchased on request. It is advisable to repair minor nicks and scratches as soon as they appear.

When placing a furniture cover over a table for an extended period of time, it is recommended to first place an empty plastic pot plant in the centre of the table, then placing the furniture cover over the top. This will prevent the possibility of the furniture cover adhering to the table surface.

WARRANTY

Powder coat is a decorative finish for indoor and outdoor use. While it assists with metal protection, it is not a corrosion protection in its own right. The components of Tait powder coated products are produced in either aluminium, stainless steel or mild steel.

The mild steel base materials are treated with two levels of pre-protection that guard against corrosion. The products are then powder coated to make the surface resistant to corrosion and suitable for use in exterior environments.

Minor corrosion spots at the weld joins – under table tops, bases and seat frames, may be evident on mild steel products. These do not affect the structural integrity of the product and are not covered by the Tait warranty.

Whilst every care is taken to provide the most suitable finish according to the use and the environment the product will be subjected to, Tait cannot guarantee this decorative finish against scratching, scuffing, chipping, fading or corrosion as a result of use in harsh seafront, extreme or environments where chlorine is present.

Tait offer a range of powder coat colours which offer excellent UV stability and are suitable for use in outdoor applications. Whilst powder coat offers excellent colour retention, natural fading is not covered under the Tait warranty. To ensure longevity of this finish please refer to the care and maintenance.

The warranty does not cover any occurrence of detritus, organic or man-made matter settling on the product surface. The warranty also excludes buildup of mineral deposits leaching from soils and fertilisers, should it occur on the surface of Tait's planters. Nor does this warranty cover any product corrosion directly caused by aforementioned matter.

Tait assume no responsibility for product damage caused by the use of furniture covers.

PORCELAIN

CARE & MAINTENANCE

Porcelain is both stylish and practical. Tait recommends porcelain as it is one of the best low maintenance, durable and reliable surface options.

Being non-porous, porcelain is hygienic, it offers stain, scratch and thermal shock resistance and is suited for use in external environments. Because colour is fired into the tile's body, the colour will not fade even when exposed to direct sunlight and its colour-sucking UV rays.

In caring for your porcelain surface,

DO:

- Regular, basic cleaning with warm water, mild soap and a soft, non-abrasive cloth
- Use gentle, everyday multipurpose spray cleaner
- Immediately wash away stains such as red wine, food, oils and drinks
- For stubborn stains use a gentle, every day, non-abrasive, multipurpose spray cleaner, sugar soap, cream-based house cleaners or bicarbonate soda mixed with warm water
- Always dry your porcelain thoroughly after cleaning

DO NOT:

- Use cleaning products that contain acids, ammonia or other harsh chemicals
- Expose porcelain to permanent inks or dyes
- Use sharp utensils on a porcelain top
- Sit or stand on

When placing a furniture cover over a table for an extended period of time, it is recommended to first place an empty plastic pot plant in the centre of the table, then placing the furniture cover over the top. This will prevent the possibility of the furniture cover adhering to the table surface.

While porcelain is resistant to scratches, etches and stains, it is not damage proof. Careless handling, treatment or misuse of our products can result in damage and is not covered under our manufacturer's warranty.

WARRANTY

At Tait we prefer Ascale Porcelain manufactured in Spain. The panels are tough and scratch resistant, not scratch proof. They will easily withstand daily use. Always using cutting boards when preparing food, and avoid sliding heavy metallic objects along service, to protect it from scratching and scuffing.

Porcelain products are bound by the warranty of the supplier. Tait provides no warranty direct or indirect, implied or referred.
